What are we doing?

From Monday 14 October for approx. six weeks, we will be rebuilding the Riccarton Road carriageway between Division Street and west of the Straven/Clarence intersection. This work will be carried out during both days and nights, but we will not work between Friday night and Sunday afternoon.



How will we rebuild the road?

We need to excavate the carriageway using a milling machine and excavators. We will then reconstruct the road in multiple layers of varying materials. We will work on the north side of the road first and move from Division Street towards Straven Road.

We will return early next year to adjust service lids, add line marking, green surfacing and additional streetscaping such as the tree-lined central median.

Our work can change

We are doing our best to give you accurate timeframes but unforeseen issues like buried obstructions and unknown services can make work take longer.

Alternately, sometimes we find ways to speed up, which means we may carry out some works sooner than expected - and be gone sooner!

Riccarton Road - Road Rebuild and Resurfacing

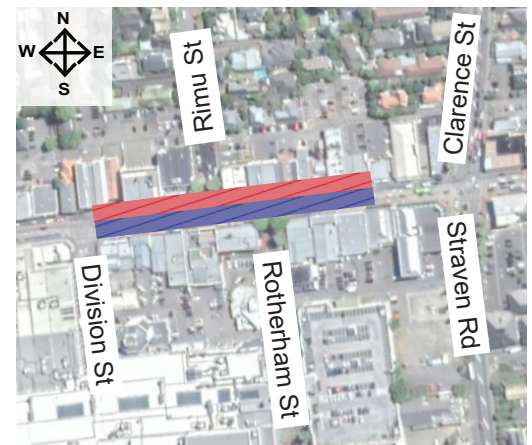

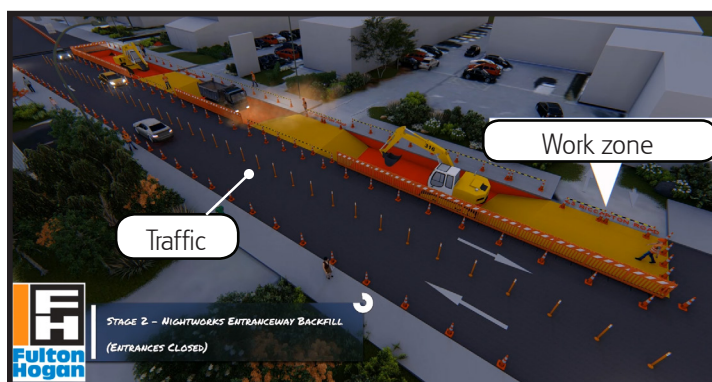
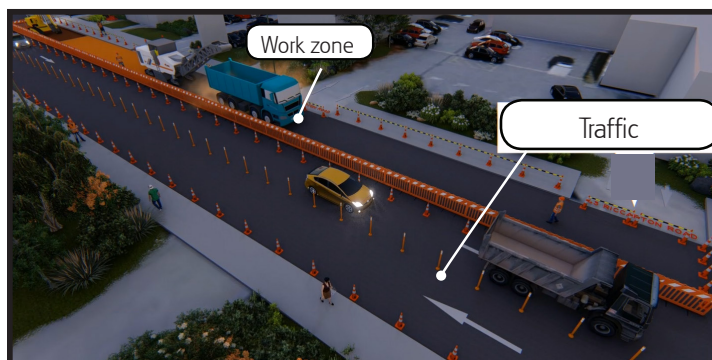
24 hour work

Work will be carried out both during the day and at night. Night shift is between the hours of 7:00pm and 7:00am.

- The crew need lights to see what they are working on - you will notice extra light coming from the street.
- There will be noise from trucks, machinery and the crew working overnight.
- We know that night works are more disruptive, we will aim to get the noisiest work carried out first and to complete the work as quickly as we can.

Top left and bottom left: an example of the traffic management.

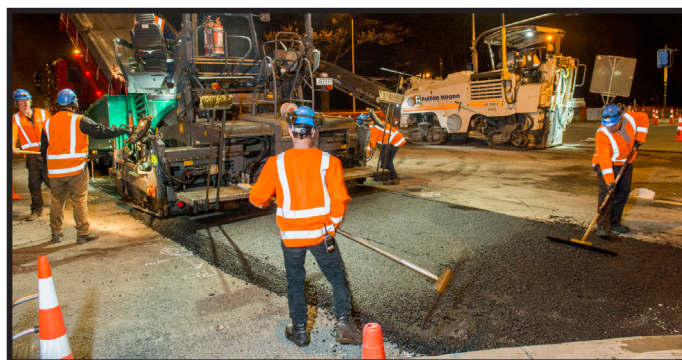


Traffic & pedestrian impacts

Traffic on Riccarton Road will remain two way but lane shifts will be in place. Traffic will be one way citybound between 10.00pm - 6.00am, Sunday to Thursday. When we work in front of side streets (Division St, Rimu St and Rotherham St) there will be partial road closures in place.

There will be no on-street parking on either side of the road. Pedestrian access will be removed at Rimu Street for a time but access to shops will be maintained. Please be on the lookout for changes in traffic management and follow the signs.
